

## **2023 Resource Planning and Development Procurement Process** Questions, Answers, and Amendments

- **Question 1:** Does the renewable energy project have to be located in the State of California?
- Answer:No. The District will entertain offers as long as the proposed renewable project meets<br/>the requirements of sections 3203 (a)(1)(A) or (B) of the California Energy Commission's<br/>Regulations Specifying Enforcement Procedures for the Renewable Portfolio Standard<br/>for Local Publicly Owned Electric Utilities for Portfolio Content Category 1 products.
- Amendment: The fourth bullet point of Part 1, section A (2) of the 2023 Resource Planning and Development Procurement Process document (page 2) currently states:
  - Projects must be located within California, and within a California balancing authority.

It shall be amended as follows:

• Projects must be located within a California balancing authority area, directly interconnected to a California balancing authority area, or have its first point of interconnection to an electricity distribution system used to serve end users within the metered boundaries of a California balancing authority area.
