NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR ADOPTION OF THE GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY PLAN BY MODESTO IRRIGATION DISTRICT FOR THE MODESTO SUBBASIN UNDER THE SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT ACT

The Modesto Irrigation District Board of Directors shall hold a public hearing to consider adoption of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for the portion of the Modesto Subbasin (DWR Bulletin 118 Groundwater Basin: 5-022.02) covered by the Stanislaus and Tuolumne Rivers Groundwater Basin Association Groundwater Sustainability Agency. The GSP was prepared in response to passage of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act of 2014 and applies to the Modesto Subbasin. The Modesto Subbasin extends between Stanislaus and Tuolumne Counties and is bounded by the Stanislaus River to the north, Tuolumne River to the south, and San Joaquin River to the west.

Members of the public, agencies, and other interested parties are invited to participate in the Tuesday, December 14 public hearing at 9 a.m. Comments received during the public hearing will be considered by the MID Board of Directors for its determination to adopt the proposed GSP.
